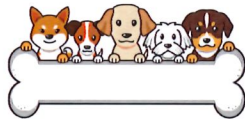

control at all times and must remain on your
property unless leashed and in your control.

at the RCUM Office.



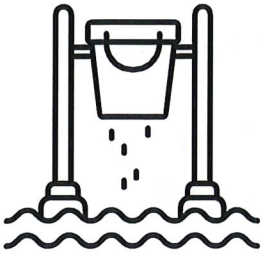
