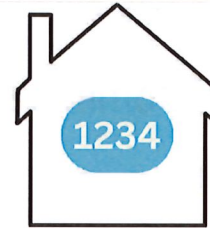
All dogs big or small, don't forget to tag them all! Tags can be purchased at the Rural Community Office.
