



You MUST show your proof of Rabies Vaccination before you can purchase your tags.

Tags are a one time thing. If you lose your tag, you can purchase a replacement for a small fee of \$3. Your dog must be kept in your control at all times and must remain on your property unless leashed and in your control.

Every Garbage Day you are allowed:

6-7 bags of garbage
One large item

Examples: couch, chair, rug, mattress, box spring, tv, microwave, dresser, etc

Windows are accepted if you have a large window or patio door glass should be removed and packaged separately. Examples boxed or in a pail.

We don't accept: Sand, gravel, rocks, bricks, manure, dead animals, car or snowmobile parts, propane tanks, trees, lumber, oil, construction materials, hazardous waste, human waste, dog waste, tires or items heavier then 50lbs. All items should be bagged, boxed or tied!

All items roadside 6am on your regular day.


