




All dogs big or small, don't forget to tag them all! Tags can be purchased at the Rural Community Office.

You MUST show your proof of Rabies Vaccination before you can purchase your tags.

Tags are a one time thing. If you lose your tag, you can purchase a replacement for a small fee of \$3. Your dog must be kept in your control at all times and must remain on your property unless leashed and in your control.

It is important to have your number posted in front of your home in a clearly visible place.


